

TAYLOR SWIRL HAT – V2

Knit Pattern



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Will stretch to fit head circumference of 18-22" (20-25")

YARN

FILTES BRILLO LAME (50 gr): 2 balls
#4111 Mustang

KNITTING NEEDLES

US Size 9 / 5.5 mm circular and double-point needles *or size to obtain gauge*

CROCHET HOOK

US Size H8 / 5 mm

GAUGE

14.5 sts = 4" / 10 cm in Pattern Stitch.

Gauge is measured after blocking. Take time to check gauge to ensure

As written, this pattern works best with the recommended yarns. Every effort has been made to ensure that the directions contained in this pattern are accurate and complete; however, we cannot be responsible for individual variance, human or typographical errors.

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Cast on 71 (77) stitches with circular needles. Join to form a circle, being careful not to twist sts. Place marker to mark beginning of round.

(K3, P3) around.

Continue till piece measures 7" if adding edging (7½" if not adding edging). On final round, increase by 1 st.....[72 (78) sts].

Decrease

Continuing in Pattern and switching to double point needles when needed:

Rd 1: *(Work 4 st, purl 2 sts together), rep * around – 60 (65) sts remain.

Rd 2: *(Work 3 st, purl 2 sts together), rep * around – 48 (52) sts remain.

Rd 3: *(Work 2 st, purl 2 sts together), rep * around – 36 (39) sts remain.

Rd 4: *(Work 1 st, purl 2 sts together), rep * around - 24 (26) sts remain.

Rd 6: *(Purl 2 sts together), rep * around – 12 (13) sts remain.

Finishing:

Cut yarn, leaving a tail of about 6". Weave through remaining stitches, removing stitches from knitting needle. Draw up tightly. Weave in loose ends.

Edging (Optional):

With crochet hook, slip stitch yarn at cast on edge.

Rd 1: *(Ch4, sk 2 sts, sl st in next st), rep * around.

Rd 2: Sl st in 1st ch4-sp, *(Ch4, sl st in next ch4-sp), rep * around.

Bind off. Weave in loose ends.

For best results, block your hat.
